Ghana team contributes US\$830,000 to combat impact of Covid-19



Our company in Ghana has committed more than US\$830,000 to fight the Covid-19 pandemic among employees and communities at its Tarkwa and Damang mines. As part of these funding plans, we have contributed US\$434,000 via the Ghana Chamber of Mines to support the efforts by the Ghana Government to reduce the spread of the coronavirus and assist the most vulnerable among the country's population.

The Ghana Chamber of Mines contribution

The total donation by the Ghana Chamber of Mines amounts to over US\$2m and will help government buy essential medical equipment such as ventilators, equip key testing centres around the country and purchase PPE for health care workers.

In our mines and communities we are spending about US\$400,000 directly to support employees and host communities. This amount covers the purchase of hand-held thermometers, sanitisers, goggles, facemasks, protective gowns and other Covid-19 prevention equipment. We have also developed and sponsored radio programmes to educate and sensitise host communities about Covid-19.
