Since the Level 3 lockdown rules and the recent eased restrictions came into effect, more shops are open, and more learners have returned to school. Despite this easing, it is very important that we do not relax our new behaviours and habits. It is not business as usual, and Gauteng now has more cases of COVID-19 than any other province, and the rate of infections and fatalities is going to continue to rise. Self-discipline is now more important than ever to prevent infections and protect those who are vulnerable.

I want to remind you that as a country we are still under lockdown conditions. This means that people should only travel for work and essential purposes, such as buying groceries or seeing a doctor, or as guided by legislation. The eased lockdown restrictions are not a green light to go back to normal social interaction. If you do, you are not only putting your health at risk, but also that of your family and colleagues. Any reckless behaviour could result in serious consequences we know you would not want for yourself or anyone you care about.

Let's work together

At all times, not just at work, but at home and in our communities, we must all continue to follow the processes and procedures that we have in place at South Deep. We need to adopt the same level of care when we are at home, in our communities and when we are travelling. We also need to be courageous and take on leadership roles in our community by showing and telling those around us how to behave to reduce the spread of the virus. Everyone needs to do their part so that our healthcare system can cope, and we protect people who are most vulnerable.

Hence my ongoing appeal to you:

- If you are ill, or if you have been in contact with someone with COVID-19, please stay at home and advise the call centre of your situation.
- If you have had a COVID-19 test and you are waiting for your results, please go into quarantine until your results are known. Stay at home and do not travel. If your results are positive you must self-isolate for the required 14 days until you are contacted to re-test.

At South Deep, we will continue doing our part as a responsible corporate citizen and employer to limit the spread of COVID-19. Our testing and screening measures and health and safety protocols are more relevant and more important than ever. We do not want to reach the point where the province, our sector or even our mine is told to go back to the previous lockdown restrictions.





You will receive this document via WhatsApp and email, and we encourage you to share this information with your family and friends so they know what to do if you, or one of them test positive for COVID-19.
